Unlimited visits and acute medication at one of the Medical Society facilities. For assistance to find the Medical Society facility closest to you, call 0861 00 11 31 or send a "please call me" to 079 409 18 34. In areas where there is a Medical Society facility, you have to consult with a professional nurse prior to going to a Network GP.

If within a 10km radius of any Medical Society facility, a member is required to make use of that facility. Where such facility is not available, you can contact Affinity Health on 0861 00 11 31 to find a network GP. Pre-authorisation is required from the 6th visit in a one year cycle.

Unlimited telephonic medical consultations including over the counter medication authorised by one of our medical professionals. This benefit is easily accessible by sending a "please call me" to 079 409 1834 when you are concerned about your health. Using this benefit will not count as a doctor's visit, so your first 5 doctors' visits, which do not need pre-authorisation, will be spared.

Linked to GP consultation as you must be referred by a doctor for this benefit. Only approved x-rays and blood tests as per the formulary will be covered.

A maximum of R1000 for every 12 months. Only medication approved by Affinity Health and according to formulary reference pricing will be covered. Please call NBCRFLI Health Customer Care so we may direct you to the nearest pharmacy.

Subject to formulary reference pricing as approved by Affinity Health. You must be registered as a Chronic member in order to obtain this benefit. To confirm if your chronic condition is covered, you can contact the NBCRFLI Health Customer Care line.

Available for members that are registered for Chronic medication. Through support we hope to assist you in bringing your condition under control and being able to live a normal life.

Available by phoning the number provided on the membership card. If another service provider is used, costs may not be covered if deemed not an emergency. This benefit includes repatriation of mortal remains if death occurs away from normal place of residence.

For actual costs of emergency casualty hospitalisation if admitted due to an accident up to the maximum amount of R75 000 per incident. Please phone the pre-authorisation number on your membership card for a Guarantee of Payment. Claims older than 4 months will not be accepted.

A funeral assistance benefit of R10 000 is payable in the event of the death of the Eligible Member. Claims older than 6 months will not be accepted.

Members must make contact with the NBCRFLI Health Customer Care via 0861 00 11 31 or send a "please call me" to 079 409 1834. Members will be validated and advised of the process to follow to visit one of the Spec Savers stores.

The Council is governed by the Labour Relations Act of 1995, which allows for registered employer and employee organisations to establish a bargaining council for an industry and area. Through collective bargaining, trade unions and employer organisations, which are party to the Council, are able to negotiate matters that are of mutual interest to the Road Freight and Logistics Industry. This approach allows for better regulation of matters which affect the Industry as a whole, thereby enforcing minimum standards and conditions of employment within the Road Freight and Logistics Industry which contributes to labour stability within the Industry. The Council also supports industry members through managing the industry's annual leave, sick leave and holiday bonus funds, and by providing health and wellness services.
